



Religious education director among 11 facing child porn charges

Rhode Island State Police said Tuesday that they arrested 11 suspects in a child pornography crackdown, including a registered sex offender and a religious education director.

Police said the 11 suspects will be arraigned on charges of possession of child pornography and transfer of child pornography. Investigators said there is no indication that any of the men had inappropriate contact with children.

The arrests follow a three-month undercover investigation. Officers seized digital media, including images and videos, from the suspects' homes.

Police said one of the suspects, Gary Kabler of East Providence, is the director of education and teaches religious school classes at Temple Habonim in Barrington. Also arrested was Donald Moore of Warwick, a convicted sex offender registered with the state. He was arrested on the possession charge for a second time.
